Digital Literacy



The Welsh Baccalaureate aims to enable learners to develop and demonstrate an understanding of and proficiency in essential and employability skills which includes **Digital Literacy**.

The course will be delivered by:

Sangeet Bhullar of 'WISE KIDS' who promote innovative, positive and safe internet use through the provision of innovative training programmes, consultancy and resource development in the areas of Digital Literacy, Digital Citizenship, Digital Participation and Online Safety.

Allen Heard, who is an experienced ICT teacher from Ysgol Bryn Elan, Colwyn Bay. The school has been selected as a Digital Pioneer School that will work with a select few schools across Wales to shape the curriculum for the future.

Aims

- To provide staff with relevant content and access to resources in order to deliver digital literacy.
- To upskill staff in using digital tools/techniques to present numerical data (tables, graphs and diagrams) and social media for marketing and promotion.

Session 1 (am)

1. Use social media creatively, effectively and safely.
2. Understand and manage own digital footprint.
3. Understand and respond appropriately to risks and problems in order to communicate safely in a digital world.
4. Evaluate the reliability of sources of information.

Session 2 (pm)

1. Use digital techniques and methods for a range of activities including: collaboration, team working, creativity, problem solving and learning.
2. Use, manipulate or create data and information and present it digitally for different audiences.
3. Be able to find, organise, store, manage, share and protect digital information.

Sesiwn 1 (am)

1. Defnyddio cyfryngau cymdeithasol yn greadigol, yn effeithiol ac yn ddiogel.
2. Deall a rheoli ôl-troed digidol eu hunain.
3. Deall ac ymateb yn briodol i risgiau a phroblemau er mwyn cyfathrebu yn ddiogel mewn byd digidol.
4. Gwerthuso dibynadwyedd ffynonellau gwybodaeth.

Sesiwn 2 (pm)

1. Defnyddio technegau digidol a dulliau ar gyfer amrywiaeth o weithgareddau gan gynnwys: cydweithio, gweithio mewn fîm, creadigrwydd, datrys problemau a dysgu.
2. Defnyddio, trin neu greu data a gwybodaeth a'i gyflwyno yn ddigidol ar gyfer gwahanol gynulleidfaoedd.
3. Gallu dod o hyd, trefnu, storio, rheoli, rhannu a diogelu gwybodaeth ddigidol.
